LEE RITENOUR

Lee will be appearing with his incredible special guest performers Patrice Rushen, Brian Bromberg and Will Kennedy. True to its intriguing and provocative title, Lee Ritenour's latest release *Smoke N' Mirrors* takes listeners on a magical, multi-faceted global journey unlike any other in the legendary guitarist's three decade career. His nearly 40 album career includes a Grammy® win for the album *Harlequin* and he has earned 17 Grammy® nominations. Ritenour's sideman days are the stuff of musical industry lore. His nearly 2,000 recordings include artists ranging from Paul Simon, Ray Charles, Stevie Wonder and Steely Dan to Herbie Hancock and Pink Floyd's *The Wall*.



LORI ANDREWS

Lori Andrews takes the harp beyond tradition and into the elements of jazz, fusion, R&B and has 7 CD's to her credit. She's performed for Presidents Clinton and Ford along with Barbra Streisand, Frank Sinatra, Oprah Winfrey (50th birthday) and Clint Eastwood. She is the recipient of the *Jazziz* Readers poll as best harpist.



PAUL CARMAN & FOURBITS

Front man Paul Carman on saxophone, Joey Sellers on trombone, Chris Symer on acoustic bass and Kendall Kay on drums will bring a fresh sound to the festival. Paul Carman is a veteran of the Frank Zappa Band of the late 1980's and has led many of his own original jazz groups over the years including *Mother Tongue*, *E.S.P.*, *Triorbits*, and *Flying V*.



YVE EVANS

Yve Evans is a self-proclaimed, "Private party in a public place." There is an intangible quality in her music that gives it a life of its own; reaching out and touching the souls of the people. This Grammy® nominated, classically trained, multi-faceted performer travels the world sharing not only the music but the message of Jazz.

DAVE KOZ

In a career spanning nearly two decades, Dave Koz has established himself as a platinum-selling artist, humanitarian, entrepreneur, radio host, and instrumental music advocate. As the recipient of six Grammy® nominations, the list of artists who Koz has played with bears testament to his talent and includes such musical luminaries as Burt Bacharach, Ray Charles, Natalie Cole, Celine Dion, Kenny Loggins, U2, Michael McDonald, Luther Vandross, and Rod Stewart. In 2007, Koz released two chart-topping collections of standards. *At The Movies*, his lush, romantic celebration of timeless melodies from cinema which spent eight weeks atop Billboard's Top Contemporary Jazz chart.



PETER SPRAGUE

Peter's seven-piece group is a gathering of two different worlds — a group comprised of a classical string quartet and a jazz trio. These worlds intertwine and explore a soundscape rich in harmony riding on the rhythmic pulse of the Brazilian samba and jazz swing.



NAJITE AGINDOTAN AFRICAN ENSEMBLE

Son of an Urhobo tribal chieftain, Najite Agindotan is a master percussionist who, from a very young age, traveled with the Urhobo cultural music troupe under his father's direction. They traveled throughout West Africa and performed at national festivals in their native Nigeria.



BOB BOSS

Bob Boss' influences come from jazz & rock and roll jazz playing with Jimmy & Jeannie Cheatham, Sherry Williams and an eclectic mix of pop musicians from Arlo Guthrie to Pia Zadora. He's been featured on *The Tonight Show w/Jay Leno*, *CBS This Morning*, *Entertainment Tonight* and nationally syndicated shows in France, Holland & Belgium.

LOCATION: Idyllwild is located in the cool, clean air of the San Jacinto mountains on Highway 243, only two hours from Los Angeles or San Diego, one hour from Palm Springs or Palm Desert. Highway 243 is accessible from Interstate 10 at Banning or off Highway 74 from Hemet or Palm Desert. The festival is held amid the towering native pine and oak on the Idyllwild Arts campus.

TIME: Gates open at 10 A.M. each day. Music begins at 11 A.M.

VENUES & SEATING: There is no reserved seating in the Holmes Amphitheater, except for the Patron's area. You are welcome to bring cushions or folding chairs (low chairs, please, to allow everyone a good view). There is seating in Stephens Recital Hall and the French Quarter Bistro; however, it is not reserved. Wine and beer are available for purchase at all three venues.

PARKING: All parking is free. Free shuttles run from clearly marked parking locations in Idyllwild and from the center of the village. Special parking is available for cars with valid handicap plates.

FINE ARTS & CRAFTS: Outstanding artists and artisans from across California will display and sell their handmade art.

FOOD & BEVERAGES: Beer, wine, soft drinks and a wide array of food concessions are located in the Picnic in the Pines area.

WINE TASTING: Premium wine tasting will be available for \$5 and a commemorative Jazz in the Pines wine glass can also be purchased for \$5.



WHAT CAN BE BROUGHT IN: Coolers: 15 inches long and 12 inches wide or smaller. Chairs with backs up to 36 inches in height.

WHAT CANNOT BE BROUGHT IN: No alcoholic beverages or pets of any kind. Service dogs have full access. The management reserves the right to search ice chests, back packs and other containers.

LODGING: Charming cabins, inns and vacation home rentals are set amid the forested villages of Idyllwild, Pine Cove, and Fern Valley, and can be reserved to spend a weekend or longer. There are three campgrounds in Idyllwild and several others close by.
